Members thoroughly enjoyed the excellent presentation given by Don Munro at our presentation meeting on 24 April on Minimalism.

Minimalist photography is about stripping a subject down to its most elegant essence, to create photos that cut through the clutter by emphasizing the essentials, including clean lines and empty spaces. Don explained that there are different 'schools' of Minimalism -

- 1. Formalist (USA 1960's)
- 2. Russian Avant-garde (1917-24)
- 3. Constructivism and Suprematism
- 4. Japanese Aesthetics (10th century)

Minimalist photography does not depict the world in a realistic way. It rarely puts the main subject in the centre or on the "rule" of thirds, and rarely has a foreground, mid-ground or background. It is meant to show the "essence" of a scene in its most simplistic form.

This was a very interesting presentation which promoted the opportunity to look at things in a completely different way, allowing you to become 'absorbed' in what the essence of the scene or subject is.

Don has kindly forwarded a copy of the presentation, and asks us to not distribute the presentation outside of the Society - for MPS members only


