

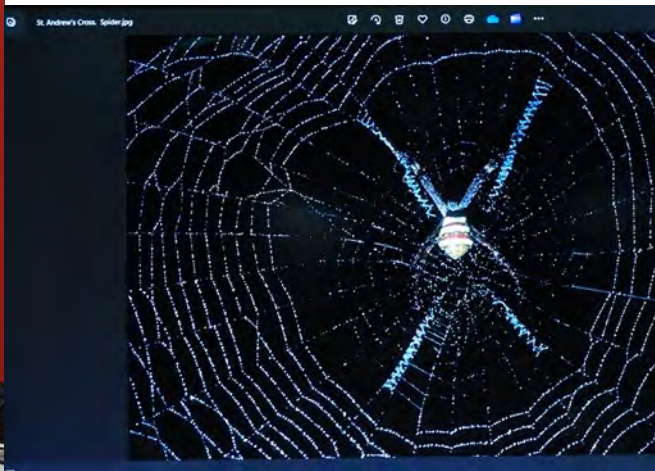

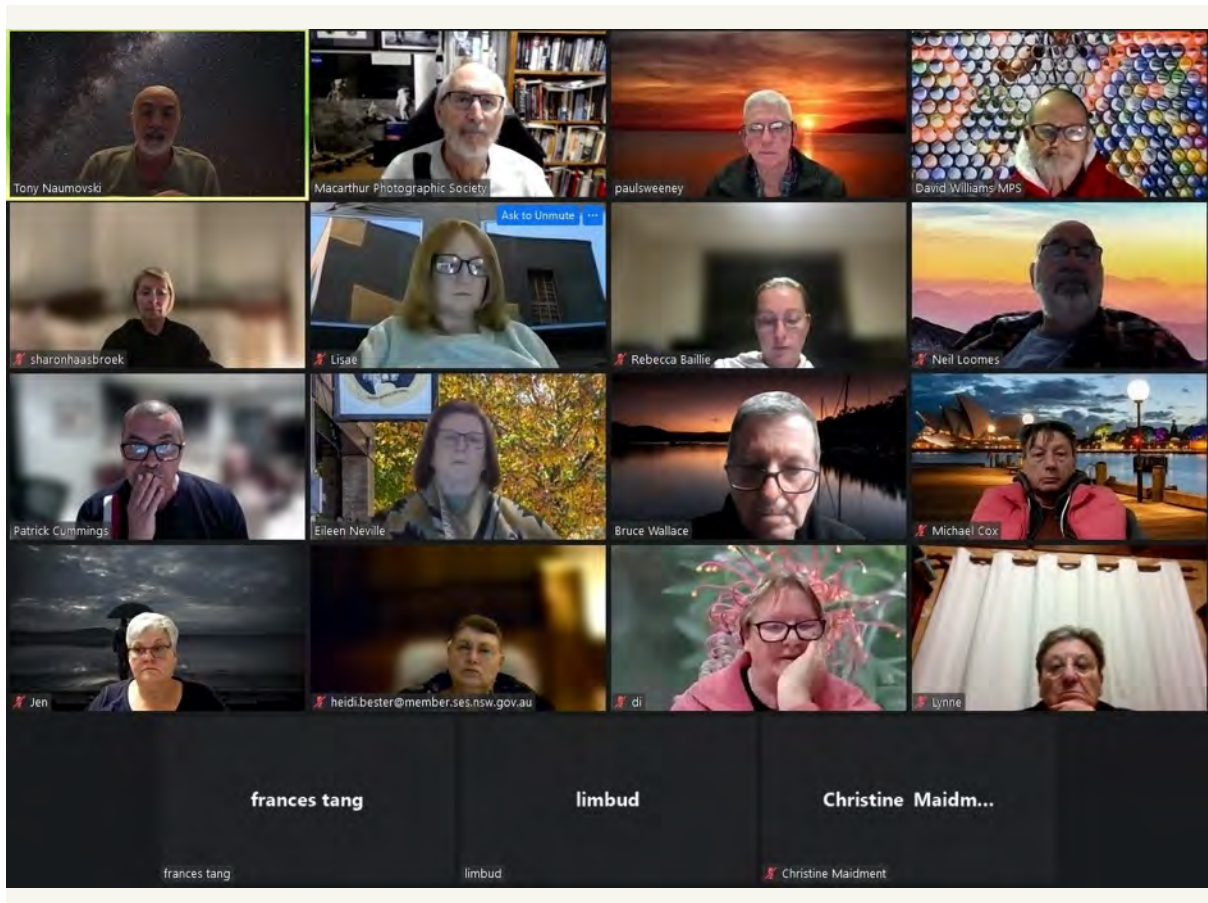
Outing - Wednesday July 17

On Wednesday July 17 we are visiting The Maritime Museum in Darling Harbour, to view their Wildlife Photographer of the Year Exhibition, featuring Juliette Pavy, the Sony World Photographer of the Year 2024.
