

Our Interstate Interclub

This year, Macarthur Photographic Society will be joining **Rosanna Photography Club** in Melbourne, for an interstate interclub. This is an exciting opportunity to branch out and engage with photography clubs from other states.

After much discussion with the President of Rosanna, Geoff Kaiser, and MPS Secretary Marie McLaurin, it has been agreed to hold an interclub competition between us and our interstate friends.

Two Interclubs this year

The event will be held very close to our standard Interclub with St George Photographic Society and Port Hacking Camera Club. Our standard interclub between MPS, Port Hacking and St George, will be held on <u>Wednesday 27 August 2025</u>; the Rosanna PS Interclub will be held on <u>Thursday 14 August 2025</u>, via Zoom.

Here is some background information on how the Rosannna competition will run, with further details being provided as we move along -

- The competition will be attended by both clubs via Zoom
- The Rosanna Photography Club will appoint an independent judge
- Each club will submit 20 images (1-2 photos from each member) by 15
 July 2025

- The theme is to be "Through a Window" and images can be colour or black and white
- Digital images are to be JPEG and have a maximum dimension of 1920 x 1080 pixels. Maximum file size 2 MG and cannot be any more than 5 years old
- Images will be sent through to the Competition Secretary (MPS) who will collate entries and create score sheet

The **Rosanna** Interclub will be announced before each meeting between now and July, and if you are interested in joining the interclub competition and would like more information, please contact MPS Secretary Marie McLaurin, or send an email using the button below.

The **Sydney** Interclub, with St George and Port Hacking Camera Club will be held at our community hall - Currans Hill Community Hall - on 27 August 2025. We will be having dinner beforehand at Formosa Asian Cuisine Restaurant, Shop 2/5 Iando Way, Currans Hill, and will commencing at 5:30pm.

The images for the Sydney Interclub will be chosen from our Image of the Month images over the past 12 months, by a panel compiled by the President and our Competition Secretary.
